



A Heavenly Sign Revelation 12:1-2

- Now a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars.
- ² Then being with child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth.



A Heavenly Sign — Revelation 12:3-4

And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and seven diadems on his heads.

⁴ His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was ready to give birth, to devour her Child as soon as it was born.

Hippolytus, Tyconnius, Victorinus of Petovium said:

 This view, however, is popular among both Catholics and Protestants. On the Catholic side of the ledger, Hippolytus, Victorinus of Petovium, and Tyconnius invoke this view. Typical is Victorinus, who notes that "the woman clothed with the sun, and having the moon under her feet, and wearing a crown of twelve stars upon her head, and travailing in her pains, is the ancient Church of fathers, and prophets, and saints, and apostles, which had the groans and torments of its longing until it saw that Christ, the fruit of its people according to the flesh long promised to it, had taken flesh out of the selfsame people. Moreover, being clothed with the sun intimates the hope of resurrection and the glory of the promise. And the moon intimates the fall of the bodies of the saints under the obligation of death, which never can fail. For even as life is diminished, so also it is increased.

C. C. Rowland said:

"Talk about Satan is avoided by some liberally minded people. It seems to reflect the beliefs of simple-minded believers or the fantasies of infancy, which mature adults should have grown out of. The demonic world, particularly when it dwells on destruction, is one we may find distasteful even pathological. We may find ourselves reacting negatively to images of hostility and polarization or, rightly, reluctant to 'demonize' others. The symbolism of evil in the Bible is a problem, and yet it is a potent resource to help us to comprehend the forces that upset and subvert our managed lives. Satan symbolizes that which stands between humans and the divine presence, and the personification of him as a dragon or a serpent is a sign of the reality of evil. As Revelation indicates, the manifestation of Satan's power is complex. It is institutional and social as well as personal. Thus the beast is a concrete embodiment of evil power. Evil does not take the form of a single king but an imperial institution or structure; it is a way of operating, and its agents of propaganda take many shapes."

M. C. Reddish said:

 "Many modern readers may feel somewhat uneasy with this chapter. In some circles, any talk of the reality of evil is considered naïve and unsophisticated. As Walter Wink has observed, 'Our culture resolutely refuses to believe in the real existence of evil, preferring to regard it as a kind of systems breakdown that can be fixed with enough tinkering.' This aversion to speaking about evil is particularly true if one speaks of evil in terms of a Satan figure. But this chapter, indeed all of Revelation, forces us to face squarely the problem of evil in our world. Whether one chooses to retain the traditional imagery of Satan and demons to speak of the presence of evil in the world, or to demythologize the language of evil and recast our understanding in modern terminology, one cannot remain true to the biblical witness if he does not recognize that evil is a reality, indeed a force, threatening to overwhelm us. What is important is not the imagery depicting evil, but rather the resolve to resist evil and align ourselves with God."


Revelation 12:7-9


The King of Tyre Ezekiel 28:15-17

Contemporary Charles Feinberg said:

"The author cannot follow those views which inject without support a foreign and false mythology, a legendary atmosphere or a hypothetical ideal personality. It cannot be conceded that Ezekiel was following a free imagination which admittedly was not ideal with him. Instead, he appeared to have the situation of his day in mind with his attention riveted upon the ruler of Tyre, the embodiment of the people's pride and godlessness. But as he viewed the thoughts and ways of that monarch, he clearly discerned behind him the motivating force and personality who was impelling him in his opposition to God.

Contemporary Charles Feinberg continued:

In short, he saw the work and activity of Satan, whom the king of Tyre was emulating in so many ways. Recall the incident in Matthew 16:21–23 where Peter was rebuked by our Lord Jesus. No sterner words were spoken to anyone in Christ's earthly ministry. But He did not mean that Peter had somehow become Satan himself; He was indicating that the motivation behind Peter's opposition to His going to Calvary was none other than the prince of the demons. This appears to be a similar situation. Some liberal expositors admit that it would appear that Ezekiel had in mind some spirit or genius of Tyre comparable to the angelic powers and princes in the book of Daniel who are entrusted with the affairs of nations."

Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time."



Revelation 12:13-17

13 Now when the dragon saw that he had been cast to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male Child. 14 But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent. ¹⁵ So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood. ¹⁶ But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the flood which the dragon had spewed out of his mouth. ¹⁷ And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.
